Salina Food 4 Flight Food Drive & Travel Voucher Rules and Restrictions

Non-perishable food drop-offs must be made at a designated location during their regular business hours. Each individual must bring in at least four (4) non-perishable food items to receive a \$25.00 SeaPort Travel Voucher. One SeaPort Travel Voucher will be issued to each individual system wide (one Travel Voucher per person) at a designated drop-off site during the time of drop-off. No household limit. Vouchers can be used based on seat availability.

Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent; vouchers will be issued with the child's name, but in the care of the adult present during the time of drop-off.

SeaPort Travel Vouchers will be good for use from December 1st, 2011 to January 31st, 2012, and are not combinable with each other or any other SeaPort offer.
