Mr. McKinney will be available for questions about the festive plane and Eastern Oregon air service. All Eastern Oregon residents and visitors are invited to participate. Pendleton Mayor Philip Houck and the President of the Round-Up Association, Randy Severe, are expected to be in attendance along with Airport Manager Larry Dalrymple and other members of the community. Members of Boy Scout Troop 700 of Pendleton will also have an opportunity to meet Mr. McKinney and view the freshly decorated aircraft after having participated in an Aviation Badge program approved by Mr. McKinney earlier this summer.
